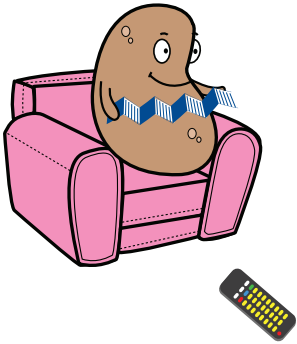

- ❑ **abstain** [əb'steɪn] (v.) 避免
You'd better abstain from alcohol for your health concern.
- ❑ **abuse** [ə'bju:z] (v.) 濫用
He constantly abuses his body with illegal drugs.
- ❑ **accident** [ˈæksədənt] (n.) 意外
Maria had a terrible car accident last week.
- ❑ **accident and emergency** (n.) (=emergency room, AmE) 急診室
Jack was taken to the accident and emergency last night due to unbearable stomachache.
- ❑ **admit** [əd'mɪt] (v.) 允許
Mr. Smith has been admitted to a hospital as a result of food poisoning.
- ❑ **aftercare** [ˈæftəˌkeə] (n.) 病後照顧
John has been under aftercare service since he left the hospital.
- ❑ **antibiotics** [ˌæntɪbaɪ'ɒtɪks] (n.) 抗生素
Antibiotics are usually used against infections.
- ❑ **attend** [ə'tend] (v.) 照顧
A nurse attends to his needs frequently.
- ❑ **aware** [ə'weɪ] (a.) 了解
He was well aware of the problem.
- ❑ **babysit** ['beɪbɪsɪt] (v.) 照顧幼兒
Jenny babysits for her neighbour on a regular basis.

- ❑ **biohazard** [ˌbaɪoʊ'hæzəd] (a.) 對生物有風險的
The product contains biohazard chemicals.
- ❑ **biological** [ˌbaɪə'lɒdʒɪkəl] (a.) 生物的
The man and the woman are the child's biological parents.
- ❑ **beware** [brɪ'weɪ] (v.) 注意
Senior citizens are warned to beware of high sodium chloride food.
- ❑ **body** ['bɒdɪ] (n.) 身體
His body was trembling.
- ❑ **care** [keə] (n.) 照顧
She has spent quite a large amount of money on skin care products.
- ❑ **circulation** [ˌsɜ:kjə'leɪʃən] (n.) 循環
Regular exercise will improve blood circulation.
- ❑ **clinic** [ˈklɪnɪk] (n.) 診所
There is a rehabilitation clinic for alcoholics on the outskirts of the city.
- ❑ **comprise** [kəm'praɪz] (v.) 組成
Older people comprise a large proportion of those living in poverty.
- ❑ **conscious** [ˈkɒnʃəs] (adj.) 有意識的
She's very conscious of the problems involved.
- ❑ **condition** [kən'dɪʃən] (n.) 狀況
He was in no condition (=too ill) to go out.

- ❑ **convalesce** [kɒnvə'les] (v.) 休養
She is convalescing at home after her operation.
- ❑ **critical** [ˈkrɪtɪkəl] (a.) 關鍵的
He is in a critical condition in the ICU.
- ❑ **cure** [kjʊə] (v.) 治癒
Will you be able to cure him, Doctor?
- ❑ **deform** [dɪ'fɔ:m] (v.) 變形
The disease had deformed his spine.
- ❑ **degenerate** [dɪ'dʒɛnəreɪt] (v.) 退化
Her health degenerated quickly.
- ❑ **delivery** [dɪ'lɪvəri] (n.) 分娩
She had a breech delivery last week.
- ❑ **deteriorate** [dɪ'tɪəriəreɪt] (v.) 惡化
His health only deteriorated when he kept on smoking.
- ❑ **diet** [daɪət] (n.) 飲食
Prudence's decided to go on a diet (=to lose weight) before her wedding.
- ❑ **hallucination** [hə'lusən'eɪʃən] (n.) 幻覺
High temperatures can cause hallucination.
- ❑ **heal** [hi:l] (v.) 痊癒
This ointment will help to heal your cuts.
- ❑ **health** [helθ] (n.) 健康
Exhaust fumes are bad for your health.

- ❑ **ill** [ɪl] (a.) 生病的
Her father is seriously ill in St. Luke's hospital.
- ❑ **immune** [ɪ'mju:n] (a.) 免疫的
Adults are often immune to German measles.
- ❑ **incredible** [ɪn'krɛdəbəl] (a.) 不敢置信的
It is incredible that she has fully recovered from an illness in 1 day!
- ❑ **injection** [ɪn'dʒɛkʃən] (n.) 注射
He was treated with penicillin injections.
- ❑ **instant** [ɪnstənt] (a.) 立即的
She is not in instant danger.
- ❑ **insurance** [ɪn'ʃʊərəns] (n.) 保險
Sorry sir, but your health insurance doesn't cover body check-ups.
- ❑ **intoxicated** [ɪn'tɒksə'ketɪd] (a.) 中毒
He could have been arrested for DWI. (driving while intoxicated 酒駕).
- ❑ **irregular** [ɪ'regjələ] (a.) 不平均的
Her brother was smiling with irregular teeth in his mouth.
- ❑ **mature** [mə'tʃʊə] (a.) 成熟的
Jane is very mature for her age.
- ❑ **muscle** ['mʌsl] (n.) 肌肉
This exercise will work the muscles of the lower back.
- ❑ **nerve** [nɜ:v] (n.) 神經
She's still recovering from her nervous breakdown.

- ❑ **off-colour** [ɒf'kʌlə] (a.) 生病的
John came in the office this morning looking off-colour.
- ❑ **over-the-counter** [ˌovəðə'kauntə] (a.) 成藥
You may as well go to drugstores and buy over-the-counter drugs for that cough.
- ❑ **patient** [peɪənt] (n.) 病患
He's one of Dr Shaw's patients.
- ❑ **pharmacist** [ˈfɑ:məsɪst] (n.) 藥劑師
I'm sick and tired of being a pharmacist. I'm knackered every day.
- ❑ **pharmacy** [ˈfɑ:məsi] (n.) 藥局
Pharmacy is also called drug store.
- ❑ **nutritionist** [nju'triʃənɪst] (n.) 營養師
He is a qualified nutritionist.
- ❑ **nursing home** (n.) 養老院
When their children have their own careers, elder people are usually sent to nursing homes.
- ❑ **prescription** [prɪ'skrɪpʃən] (n.) 處方箋
Stinnoxes are only available on prescription.
- ❑ **recovery** [rɪ'kʌvəri] (n.) 復原
He's on the way to recovery (=getting better).
- ❑ **relaxed** [rɪ'læksɪd] (a.) 冷靜
He appeared relaxed and confident before the match.

The paramedics couldn't revive her.
- ❑ **sanitary** [ˈsænətəri] (a.) 衛生的
The restaurant was forced to close as a result of sanitary problems.
- ❑ **symptom** [ˈsɪmptəm] (n.) 症狀
Symptoms include a headache and sore throat.
- ❑ **syndrome** [ˈsɪndrɒm] (n.) 症候群
This syndrome is associated with frequent coughing.
- ❑ **test** [test] (n.) 檢驗
When can I get the test of my body check-up?
- ❑ **unwholesome** [ʌn'həʊlsəm] (a.) 有害健康的
Heavy smoking may cause serious problems and is unwholesome to one's body.
- ❑ **well** [wel] (a.) 健康的
He hasn't felt well since last night's supper.
